

Are You in Compliance?

Proposition 24, CPRA Amendment to California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018

Outlined below are some key takeaways from the CPRA amendments; and ways SyberGRC can assist in achieving compliance.



General Duties of Businesses that Collect Personal Information (SEC. 4. Section 1798.100)

In addition to disclosing retention plans of customer data, entities must implement reasonable security procedures to protect the personal information from unauthorized or illegal access, destruction, use, modification, or disclosure in accordance with Section 1798.81.5.

Consumers' Right to Delete Personal Information (SEC. 5. Section 1798.105)

A consumer has the right to request that a business delete any personal information about the consumer and extend that to any 3rd party who has been given access to that same data.

Consumers' Right to Know, Access, and Correct Personal Information (SEC. 6. Section 1798.106 & SEC. 7. Section 1798.110)

A verifiable consumer request to identify, access, and correct their personal information must be obliged.

Notice, Disclosure, Correction, and Deletion Requirements (SEC. 12. Section 1798.130)

Upon receipt of a verified request, entities must identify by category or categories the personal information collected about the consumer.

Provisions to Protect Data of Minors (SEC. 24.10. Section 1798.199.55)

Any violations having to do with minors' personal information receive an automatic \$7,500 penalty under the CPRA.
